Here's an example of high quality craftsmanship. This Black walnut and white oak chest has: Black walnut Inlaid dovetail joints. Black walnut handles are steam bent. Black walnut hinges for lid and handles have ram horn carving. Black walnut tray with white oak spline joints. Handcarved claw feet made out of black walnut wood. All the wood was grown in Jerome Idaho. Fourteen inches long. Eight inches wide. Eight inches deep.
